Board Meeting notes from 8/31/09

- 1- We need a group of volunteers to form a steering committee to research and outline a "club sponsored Treasure hunt" for 2010. Dennis Gee will chair the committee.
- 2- We will also form a steering committee to outline, research, and develop a club website. Jim Nichols and John London will co-chair. Volunteers will come from the club body.
- 3- We will have nominations beginning with the September meeting for President, Vice President and two board slots. Please have your nominations ready. We will vote in November.
- 4- Mark Davey will chair a group to build a club dry washer from plans by Bill Morgan. We will pick a date at the meeting. I will send a material list after the meeting.
- 5- The board passed a motion to have a "perpetual" release form instead of a yearly form. A revised form is in this news letter. Please print and sign your copy of the new form.
- 6- Jim Nichols & Mark Davey will draft the regulations for "Adopt A Park" and could use some help/suggestions from club members.
- 7- The board recommends December 8th for our Christmas party. The membership needs to pick three (3) places to eat. We will vote on the choices. The board also set a \$750 cap for party prizes.
- 8- The board decided to continue with "after meeting" auctions. However, we request that members with items to auction pre-register the item(s) with me (John London) for the news letter.
- 9- The board passed a motion to add a classified section (non commercial) to the news letter. One item will be free, second and third items will cost \$2 each. No more than three items per person each month. There is no restriction on what may be sold.
- 10- The board also discussed the news letter. The news letter is intended to be delivered via e-mail at no charge. There are a few members that require either mail delivery or by hand at the meetings. Due to the increasing costs of postage, paper and ink, we have decided to charge a bare minimum to break even on expenses. Printed news letters mailed will be \$1.50 and hand carried will be \$1.00 per copy.
- 11- The board also voted and passed a motion on a club budget, based on current expenditures and receipts. The anticipated budget is shown below.
